



Lamington National Park Centenary Celebrations

Green Mountains - 31st July

- **10.00 am sharp** - Lamington National Park Centenary Celebrations begin, and the **Official opening of the refurbished Green Mountains Information Centre**, plus activities and Displays.
- **12- 1.00 pm** **Light Lunch at O'Reilly's** for people who have previously registered with Kim Morris
- **1.00 pm** walks to either Morans Creek camp with Rangers or the Rainforest return with Bill McDonald. Proceedings conclude at 4.00 pm.

Binna Burra 1st August

- **From 9.00 am at the Binna Burra Information Centre** - A Welcome Hot drink and refreshments served by LNHA Volunteers.
- **10.00 am sharp** - **Formal proceedings begin at the Information Centre.**
 - **David Goss (MC)** introduces **Rory O'Connor and Patricia O'Connor** (Yugambeh Museum, Language and Heritage Research Centre) who will relate the Woonoongoora story and perform welcome to country.
 - **Official opening of the refurbished Binna Burra Information Centre by Deputy Director General Ben Glaassen**

- **11.25 am Shuttle Buses leave for the "Barn"** at Binna Burra Lodge.

The "Barn" will operate as a central point for guests during the day; displays from the LNHA, GMNHA and NPAQ will provide Natural History information for interested park visitors.

- **11.55 am at the "Barn" Guest Speakers :-**
 - **Peter Ogilvie** to provide a quick overview of the park's history and the key people involved in changing it from a timber reserve to a national park and those who protected the park in its early years.
 - **Michael Fraser**, great grandson of Robert Martin Collins to speak
 - **Anne Neale**, daughter of Romeo Watkins Lahey to speak about their father
 - **Tony Groom**, son of Arthur Groom to speak about the Groom family connections with the park and Binna Burra lodge.
- **A light lunch** is offered to invited guests in the Binna Burra Barn area.
- **1.30 pm: Guided walks** are being run by Connect With Nature & LNHA Volunteers
 - **Caves circuit** from the saddle walking clockwise;
 - **Koolanbilba lookout** cultural walk with Rory O'Connor and Ranger Greg
 - **Bird and plant walk** with **Bill McDonald** along the rainforest circuit.
- **3.00 pm - 4.30 pm Shuttle Buses depart** to ferry guests back to the information centre to collect vehicles
- **5.00 pm – 6.00 pm Lamington's 100 years talk in the "Barn"** - Guest speaker, **Peter Ogilvie** will be delivering his **Lamington 100 years talk** at Barn. **Open to all guests** – limited seating for 60 people but standing room available.
