## Discover plant adaptations while visiting Lamington National Park

Can you find...

**Vines**, use other plants to get from the low-light forest floor to the light of the canopy.



**Ferns** are very common. Some grow in trees, some grow in moist shady soil.



**Large-leaved plants** grow on the moist forest floor in the shade; their large leaves maximise sunlight capture.



What are two things plants need to grow?

**Mosses** are usually found growing on tree trunks, and logs, and use these other plants to help them survive.



**Epiphytes** are plants using other plants for support to receive adequate light within the low-light rainforest environment.



**Buttress roots** are large, very wide roots that provide additional support for trees. They are commonly associated with nutrient-poor soils.
